Application

- Use of stud adhesive is not permitted in fire rated systems or tiled areas in wet areas.
- MastaGrip can be used on CCA H2, LOSP H2 and TanalithT H2F treated timbers.
- Timbers must have been treated, dried and stored in accordance with the timber manufacturer's procedures for effective bonding.
- Do not use on timber which is wet, moist, unseasoned or green.
- Frames must be clean, dry and free from grease, dust and other contaminants.
- Plasterboard must be fixed before adhesive can skin.
- For internal application only.

Optimise product performance by:

- Firmly closing the lid to prevent the compound from drying out.
- Washing tools before product dries and hardens.
- Storing in a dry, well ventilated environment fully protected from the weather.
